Drum Set:

Most important specification is that both heads are on and that the <u>heads are white coated</u> <u>"Ambassador" heads</u>, not pinstripe or black dot heads. The heads must be in good enough condition to be able to be tuned (without damage or "dents" in the skin). Older sets that have been played are appreciated. Hardware in good condition is also appreciated

The preferred sizes of the drums should be:

20" x 14" bass drum – both heads on – no stuffing – no mutes on the skins and no hole in the bass drum skin. An 18" x 14" Bass Drum is also ok IF both heads are white coated heads and can be tuned low.

12" x 8" mounted tom – mount should be from bass drum – <u>not mounted on a cymbal stand</u> - a snare stand is acceptable if no mount is on the BD

14" x 14" floor tom - w/ three legs, not mounted on a cymbal stand

5.5" or 6" x 14" snare drum


All hardware including 2 cymbal stands, hi-hat stand (w/clutch), snare stand, pedal w/ normal beater.

Drum stool, w/ adjustable height, sturdy and in good condition (no back brace please)

Flight Case or low level (kleiner tisch) table 40 cm high and a minimum of 60 x 100cm area for sticks and miscellaneous percussion equipment placed near the floor tom. Please provide some layer of cloth to cover the surface of the table.

Carpet (Teppich) for drum set.
